Solid and stiff construction with bulkheads laminated to hull and deck (partially watertight bulkheads) and laminated hull/deck joint. Well protected, deep center cockpit with fixed windscreen and sprayhood. Spacious owner's cabin aft over the entire beam of the ship and big engine room for easy maintenance access. This AMEL 54 (hull-no. #037) is a well-kept, firsthand owner's yacht.
